

2021 Election Fact Sheet

Who is eligible to vote:

Member Voting Info -

- a. Only the HNWS account holder or their spouse can vote.
- b. Only the HNWS account holder or their spouse can pick up the Absentee Ballot or Proxy.
- c. Only one vote per member.

How to vote:

1. Vote in person on Election Day - January 19, 2021. You can come to the HNWS office between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. and cast your vote by ballot.

2. Early Voting – November 30, 2020 – January 8, 2021 7 A.M. to 4 P.M.

If for any reason you are unable to attend the annual meeting on January 19, 2021, you can request an Absentee Ballot or Proxy by simply contacting Holley-Navarre Water System between 7 A.M. - 4 P.M. Monday – Friday by:

If requesting an Absentee Ballot or Proxy by email, please include the service address, name and account number in the email.

An Absentee vote is your vote. By assigning your Proxy to someone else, you are giving them the authority to vote for the candidates of their choice.

The Absentee Ballot or Proxy must be received by Holley-Navarre Water System Headquarters no later than 4:00 P.M., January 8, 2021 for your vote to count.

For your convenience, a postage paid envelope will be provided for you to return your Proxy or Ballot.
